RTA Income Disclosure Statement

- Started the quarter (4/1/2014) with 9,023 and ended the quarter (6/30/2014) with 8,790 for an average during the quarter of 8,907. Of this total, 1,538 were paid a commission for an average of 17.27% of the Subscribers. The average income was \$20.75 with the median being \$0.00.
- 6,391 (61.16%) Subscribers received no income in 2013. Median annual income for Subscribers in 2013 was \$0.00.
- In 2013 the cost incurred by a Subscriber in their first 12 months could have been between \$748.45 and \$1,098.44. This included the Initial set-up fee and monthly website hosting fee as well as the following optional items and services: E-Campus training (10 classes) fee, business cards, and fees associated with Paycard.
- In 2013, 7,706 (56.69%) of all Subscribers who were paying the required website hosting fees at the beginning of 2013 cancelled their membership with YTB during 2013. 1,365 (15.13%) of Subscribers who were paying the required website hosting fees as of 4/1/2014 cancelled their membership with YTB by 6/30/2014.
