Joint recommendation:

- 4 years incarceration with 2 years initial confinement in Wisconsin State Prison followed by 2 years extended supervision, imposed and stayed for 3 years probation with conditions including:
 - 11 months condition time with Huber
 - Absolute sobriety, no controlled substances without valid Rx
 - Full time employment
- 36 month DL revocation
- 36 month IID
- \$4,988 fine including costs + \$40.50 blood draw fee (\$3,500 cash bail paid)
- DNA sample
- AODA (assessment done 4-25-25, driver safety plan commenced 5-2-25 with Chris Shoemaker at Alarus in Grafton)
- Dismissal of PAC

The defense is requesting Huber release:

- Work at ThriveMed
- Counseling with Chris Shoemaker
- Virtual sessions with Dr. Charles Grade
- Therapy with Heather Hart Kennedy
- Random urine screens 4 times per month at Aurora Clinic in West Bend, mandatory appearance required by Physicians Assistance Program, condition of reinstatement of medical license

Ms. Moraski dob 3-1-68 has owned her residence at 1732 N Green Bay Rd, Grafton, WI 53024, since 2020. She is divorced and has two children: Gracie Moraski who graduated 5-15-25 from New England Law School and Mark Moraski age 24 who is a student at UWM. Her parents reside in Scottsdale, AZ. Her brother is a prosecutor in the US Attorney office in El Paso, Texas.

Ms. Moraski is employed at ThriveMed, S.C., 11501 N Port Washington Rd Suite G-30, Mequon, a primary care clinic. She works on site Monday-Thursday from 8-6 and at home Friday and Saturday. She will work on site 6 days per week if not permitted to work at home.

Her resume will be e-filed as a separate document. A letter from Erica Riegle, FNP, will be e-filed as a confidential document.

The following are mitigating factors:

1. Minimal prior traffic offenses other than OWIs
2. No criminal convictions other than OWIs
3. Valid license
4. No minor passengers
5. No texting or use of electronic devices
6. Cooperative
7. Responsible effort re AODA issues
8. Sincere show of remorse
9. Extra-judicial penalties – loss of medical license, must sell clinic
10. DOT lifetime revocation

There are two aggravating factors: high BAC and unsafe driving – the vehicle was driven into a field.

In 2022 Ms. Moraski suffered a TBI in a domestic violence incident involving a physical assault. After a second assault, she obtained a 4 year restraining order against the perpetrator.

Starting in March 2025, Ms. Moraski has been attending numerous self-help groups, in person or virtually depending on availability of transportation.

- Sundays: 5 p.m. or 8 p.m. meeting at New Day Club.
- Mondays: 6:30 p.m. AA meeting at Christ Church in Mequon.
- Tuesdays: 7 p.m. NA meeting at Mount Zion Lutheran in Wauwatosa.
- Wednesdays: 6:30 p.m. New Day meeting in Mequon.
- Thursdays: 8:30 p.m. AA meeting at North Shore Alano in Evanston (virtual)
- Fridays: 6:30 p.m. AA meeting at the 24 Hour Club in Thiensville.

She sees her psychiatrist Dr. Charles Grade every 4 weeks and her therapist Heather Hart Kennedy for in person sessions 4 times per week - 2 neurofeedback sessions and 2 therapy sessions.

She did an assessment on 4-25-25 at Ozaukee HHS. She enrolled in the driver safety plan with Chris Shoemaker at Alarus in Grafton and began individual counseling on 5-2-25. She has regular contact with Jayne, her AA sponsor.

I am the treating psychotherapist for the above referenced patient. Dr. Moraski has consented to the limited release of protected health information for the purpose of her court case regarding OWI 4th.

Dr. Moraski has been engaged with me in weekly psychotherapy sessions in addition to neurofeedback/EEG sessions. Neurofeedback is a form of EEG based brain retraining performed on a computer. Each session takes approximately one hour and is performed in my office. Psychotherapy sessions are sometimes performed on the same day as well. Her dates of neurofeedback are as follows: 3/21, 3/25, 3/28, 4/1, 4/6, 4/9, 4/12, 4/16, 4/21, 4/26, 4/30, 5/4, 5/7, 5/12, 5/20, 5/29, 6/4, 6/8.

Dr. Moraski has been an active participant in all therapeutic modalities and there are no missed sessions to report with the exception of rare mutual scheduling conflicts. These services are not reimbursed by her health insurance, so she pays out of pocket for them.

Thank you for using the Wisconsin Department of Transportation's website.

We currently show no vehicle registered in her name. If a driver does not have any vehicles titled or registered in their name, they are still able to get their license once all requirements are met. Getting a license issued will allow for the IID restriction timer to start.

Once she gets a driver license the required time for the IID restriction will start.

During the time of the IID restriction, she will only be able to drive Class D vehicles with an IID installed. If she purchases a vehicle, she must provide proof of the IID installation or a court exemption to avoid a cancellation of her license.

Dear Honorable Judge Muehlbauer,

I am writing to you today with a heavy heart, to express my sincere remorse for my actions resulting in my arrest on February 24, 2025. I take full responsibility for my behavior, and I understand the seriousness of my actions. I sincerely regret the risk my actions posed to others as well as to myself. As I reflect on that night, I am filled with profound regret for my choices, which not only violated the law but also fell short of the standards of respect and decency expected of me by myself, my family, the patients under my care, and this community.

My arrest in late February brought my life to an excruciatingly painful halt. Painfully examining what I have done has provided a container to begin bringing myself back together. I am actively engaged in treatment for both my alcoholism and the complex post-traumatic stress disorder (C-PTSD) that fuels the alcoholism. My current treatment includes ongoing outpatient AODA treatment, outpatient trauma-based mental health treatment, Alcoholics Anonymous recovery groups, and other supportive neurophysiologically trauma-based treatments. I do not and will not own a car.

I recognize the severity of my actions and understand the potential consequences of my choices. I am fully committed to my healing and believe that a path forward requires acknowledging my past while striving for personal growth and renewal, in essence, to do much better than I have done.

I own a small, integrative primary-care practice. I have been in practice for approximately 30 years, 15 of them in academic medicine. I witness children, adolescents, and families suffering in unique, terrible, and unprecedented ways. The medical system as a whole is challenged, unwieldy, and inaccessible to many. I am certain you have received countless letters of apology and remorse over the course of your service, pleading for compassion and mercy. I believe I understand the scope of what I have done, and I do not take lightly my failures and flawed judgement, and the risk of harm it posed to myself and others. But still I

ask for your compassion and mercy nonetheless. I can make living amends via service to the community I failed.

I currently serve approximately 900 patients, many of them as family systems. They are navigating an increasingly challenging landscape. I humbly ask for your assistance to find a way through this process that can satisfy both justice and mercy, that allows me to continue to serve.
