The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Luann Moraski (Year of Birth 1968) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 38775-21, first issued on May 23, 1997, with registration current through October 31, 2025. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services is in Grafton, Wisconsin 53024.

Prior Discipline

2. On September 18, 2013, the Board issued Order 0002624, which suspended Respondent's license unless she complied with drug and alcohol testing and treatment, along with other restrictions, for a period of five (5) years. The Order was based on facts that included Respondent's OWI(2<sup>nd</sup>) conviction on January 17, 2013, in Brown County Circuit Court Case Number 2012CT001592, and a December 2012 incident where Respondent practiced medicine while intoxicated.

3. Respondent's license was returned to full and unrestricted status on September 20, 2018.

4. On May 18, 2022, the Board issued Order 0007979, which again suspended Respondent's license unless she complied with the drug and alcohol testing and treatment, along with other restrictions, for a period of five (5) years. The Order was based on facts that included Respondent's OWI(3rd) conviction on March 3, 2021, in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case Number 2020CT000973.

5. On October 11, 2024, the stay was removed and Respondent's license was suspended pursuant to Order 0007979 because she violated the terms of Order 0007979. Her license remains suspended.

#### Current Case

6. At all times relevant to this matter, Respondent practiced as a primary care physician at her own direct primary care clinic located in Mequon, Wisconsin.

7. On May 14, 2024, the Department received a complaint alleging that Respondent had a personal relationship with a person to which she also provided medical care and treatment. Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case Number 24 MED 0229 was opened to investigate the allegations. Respondent denies engaging in unprofessional conduct and the Board has made no finding that Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as alleged.

8. On February 26, 2025, Respondent was charged in Washington County Circuit Court Case Number 2025CF000109 with OWI(4th), a felony, in violation of Wis. Stat. § 346.63(1)(a). Respondent was also charged with Failure to Keep Vehicle Under Control, a forfeiture, in violation of Wis. Stat. § 346.57(2); Inattentive Drive, a forfeiture, in violation of Wis. Stat. § 346.89(1); and Fail/Stop at Stop Sign, a forfeiture, in violation of Wis. Stat. § 346.46(1), in Washington County Circuit Court case numbers 2025TR000840, 2025TR000841 and 2025TR000842 respectively. All of the aforementioned cases remain pending.

9. Respondent has agreed to surrender her Wisconsin medical license, and right to renew that license, to resolve this matter.

10. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3) and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

#### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The SURRENDER by Respondent of her license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license number 38775-21), as well as her right to renew such license and registration, is accepted.

3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin, the Board may restore Respondent's license and registration on such terms and conditions as it may deem appropriate, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(6). Whether to grant a license and registration and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license and registration granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board.

4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin, or applies for another credential in the state of Wisconsin under Wis. Stat. chs. 440 through 480, Respondent shall pay the costs of this matter in the amount of \$1,034.00, before any petition or application for a credential will be considered by the applicable board or Department.

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STIPULATION

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Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 24 MED 0229

Respondent Luann Moraski and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney Kristen Nelson.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not

accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. Respondent is further informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order will be reported as required by the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB) Guidebook and as otherwise required by any licensure compact or any other state or federal law.

9. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.


